Federal-State Partnership for Intercity Passenger Rail Grant Program (Opp. No. FR-FSP-24-003)

**CFDA No.:** 20.326

**Purpose:** To reduce repair backlog, improve performance, and expand or establish new intercity

passenger rail service.

Eligibility: State, county, city, or township governments; and federally recognized Native

American tribes.

Funding: \$1,057,596,637; award amounts unlisted.

Historic Preservation Fund- Save America's Treasures- Collection Grants (Opp. No. P24AS00545)

**CFDA No.:** 15.929

**Purpose:** To support museums, libraries, archives, and all other "collecting" institutions in addressing the need to conserve nationally significant collections, including: physical conservation, curation, care, and collections management.

**Eligibility:** Native American tribal governments and organizations; public, state, and private institutions of higher education; state, county, special district, city, or township governments; nonprofits with or without 501(c)(3) status with the IRS (other than institutions of higher education); public or Native American housing authorities; and independent school districts.

**Funding:** \$25.5 million; awards between \$25,000

and \$750,000.

Historic Preservation Fund- Save America's Treasures- Preservation Grants (Opp. No. P24AS00544)

CFDA No.: 15.929

**Purpose:** To provide preservation and/or conservation assistance to nationally significant

historic properties and collections.

**Eligibility:** Native American tribal governments and organizations; public, state, and private institutions of higher education; state, county, special district, city, or township governments; nonprofits with or without 501(c)(3) status with the IRS (other than institutions of higher education); public or Native American housing authorities; and independent school districts.

Funding: \$25.5 million; awards between \$125,000

and \$750,000.

Humanities Research Centers on Artificial Intelligence (Opp. No. 20241211-RAI)

**CFDA No.:** 45.161

**Purpose:** To support the establishment of new collaborative humanities research centers focused on the legal, ethical, or societal implications of developing Al technologies

developing AI technologies.

**Eligibility:** Native American tribal governments and organizations; public, state, and private institutions of higher education; state, county, special district, city, or township governments; and nonprofits with 501(c) (3) status with the IRS (other than institutions of higher education).

Funding: \$2.5 million; awards up to \$500,000.

National Rural Health Information Clearinghouse Program (Opp. No. HRSA-25-009)

**CFDA No.:** 93.223

**Purpose:** To maintain and expand a national clearinghouse for information on rural health to support the improvement of health care in rural areas. **Eligibility:** Native American tribal governments and organizations; public, state, and private institutions of higher education; state, county, special district, city, or township governments; nonprofits with 501(c)(3) status with the IRS (other than institutions of higher education); small businesses; for-profit organizations



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other than small businesses; public or Native American housing authorities; and independent school districts.

Funding: One award expected of up to \$3.5 million.

State Health Insurance Assistance Program (SHIP) Grants (Opp. No. HHS-2025-ACL-CIP-SAPG-0003)

Purpose: To offer one-on-one assistance, counseling,

families, and caregivers to help them make informed

decisions about their care and benefits.

Eligibility: State governments.

Funding: \$52 million; awards between \$60,000 and

\$4.2 million.
