AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 2189 1 2 AMENDMENT NO. . Amend House Bill 2189 by replacing everything after the enacting clause with the following: 3 "Section 5. The Illinois Insurance Code is amended by 4 5 changing Section 356z.41 as follows: 6 (215 ILCS 5/356z.41) 7 Sec. 356z.41. Cost sharing in prescription insulin drugs; limits; confidentiality of rebate information. 8 (a) As used in this Section, "prescription insulin drug" 9 means a prescription drug that contains insulin and is used to 10 control blood glucose levels to treat diabetes but does not 11 12 include an insulin drug that is administered to a patient intravenously. 13 (b) This Section applies to a group or individual policy 14 15 of accident and health insurance amended, delivered, issued,

or renewed on or after the effective date of this amendatory

- 2 (c) An insurer that provides coverage for prescription
- 3 insulin drugs pursuant to the terms of a health coverage plan
- 4 the insurer offers shall limit the total amount that an
- 5 insured is required to pay for a 30-day supply of covered
- 6 prescription insulin drugs at an amount not to exceed \$35
- 7 \$100, regardless of the quantity or type of covered
- 8 prescription insulin drug used to fill the insured's
- 9 prescription.
- 10 (d) Nothing in this Section prevents an insurer from
- 11 reducing an insured's cost sharing by an amount greater than
- the amount specified in subsection (c).
- 13 (e) The Director may use any of the Director's enforcement
- powers to obtain an insurer's compliance with this Section.
- 15 (f) The Department may adopt rules as necessary to
- 16 implement and administer this Section and to align it with
- 17 federal requirements.
- 18 (g) On January 1 of each year, the limit on the amount that
- an insured is required to pay for a 30-day supply of a covered
- 20 prescription insulin drug shall increase by a percentage equal
- 21 to the percentage change from the preceding year in the
- 22 medical care component of the Consumer Price Index of the
- 23 Bureau of Labor Statistics of the United States Department of
- 24 Labor.

- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect January 1
- 2 1, 2025.".
