1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 2189

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 2189 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Illinois Insurance Code is amended by
5 changing Section 356z.41 as follows:

6 (215 ILCS 5/356z.41)

7 Sec. 356z.41. Cost sharing in prescription insulin drugs;
8 limits; confidentiality of rebate information.

9 (a) As used in this Section: 7

10 "Department" means the Department of Central Management
11 Services.

12 "Director" means the Director of Central Management
13 Services.

14 "Prescription ~~prescription~~ insulin drug" means a
15 prescription drug that contains insulin and is used to control
16 blood glucose levels to treat diabetes but does not include an

1 insulin drug that is administered to a patient intravenously.

2 (b) This Section applies to a group or individual policy
3 of accident and health insurance amended, delivered, issued,
4 or renewed on or after the effective date of this amendatory
5 Act of the 101st General Assembly.

6 (c) An insurer that provides coverage for prescription
7 insulin drugs pursuant to the terms of a health coverage plan
8 the insurer offers shall limit the total amount that an
9 insured is required to pay for a 30-day supply of covered
10 prescription insulin drugs at an amount not to exceed \$35
11 ~~\$100~~, regardless of the quantity or type of covered
12 prescription insulin drug used to fill the insured's
13 prescription.

14 (d) Nothing in this Section prevents an insurer from
15 reducing an insured's cost sharing by an amount greater than
16 the amount specified in subsection (c).

17 (e) The Director may use any of the Director's enforcement
18 powers to obtain an insurer's compliance with this Section.

19 (f) The Department may adopt rules as necessary to
20 implement and administer this Section and to align it with
21 federal requirements.

22 (g) On January 1 of each year, the limit on the amount that
23 an insured is required to pay for a 30-day supply of a covered
24 prescription insulin drug shall increase by a percentage equal
25 to the percentage change from the preceding year in the
26 medical care component of the Consumer Price Index of the

1 Bureau of Labor Statistics of the United States Department of
2 Labor.

4 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect January
5 1, 2025.".
