The Environmental Protection Act is amended by 4 5 adding Section 52.11 as follows: 6 (415 ILCS 5/52.11 new) 7 Sec. 52.11. Disposable food service containers. 8 (a) In this Section: "Disposable food service container" means service ware 9 designed for one-time use. "Disposable food service container" 10 includes, but is not limited to, service ware for take-out 11 foods, bakery products, and leftovers from partially consumed 12 meals. "Disposable food service container" does not include 13 polystyrene foam coolers, egg carton containers, ice chests 14

that are used for the processing or shipping of seafood or

service ware that is used to contain, transport, or otherwise

- 1 package raw, uncooked, or butchered meat, poultry, fish, or
- 2 seafood.
- "Polystyrene foam" means blown polystyrene and expanded or 3
- 4 extruded foams using a styrene monomer.
- 5 "Service ware" means a container, bowl, plate, tray,
- carton, cup, lid, or other item designed to contain, 6
- transport, serve, or aid in the consumption of food or 7
- 8 beverages.
- 9 "State facility" means any facility (i) that is owned and
- 10 operated by the State or leased and operated by the State and
- 11 (ii) that is the primary stationary work location for 25 or
- more State employees. "State facility" does not include any 12
- 13 facility under the jurisdiction of the legislative branch,
- 14 including the Auditor General, or the judicial branch.
- 15 (b) Beginning January 1, 2024, a State facility may not
- 16 sell or distribute a disposable food service container that is
- composed in whole or in part of polystyrene foam. 17
- (c) The prohibition in subsection (b) does not apply to 18
- (i) an entity that receives State funds to provide food to 19
- 20 needy individuals at no or nominal charge or (ii) a State
- agency that provides food to needy individuals at no or 21
- 22 nominal charge.
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 23
- 24 becoming law.".
