13	method for the treatment of tumors and cancerous cells.
14	"Radiation therapy treatment" means the delivery of
15	biological effective doses with proton therapy, intensity
16	modulated radiation therapy, brachytherapy, stereotactic body

  2 therapy, or other forms of therapy using radiation.
- (b) A group or individual policy of accident and health insurance or managed care plan that is amended, delivered, issued, or renewed on or after January 1, 2025 that provides coverage for the treatment of cancer shall not apply a higher
- 7 <u>standard of clinical evidence for the coverage of proton beam</u>
- 8 therapy than the insurer applies for the coverage of any other
- 9 <u>form of radiation therapy treatment.</u>
- 10 (c) A group or individual policy of accident and health
- insurance or managed care plan that is amended, delivered,
- issued, or renewed on or after January 1, 2025 that provides
- 13 coverage or benefits to any resident of this State for
- 14 radiation oncology shall include coverage or benefits for
- 15 medically necessary proton beam therapy for the treatment of
- 16 cancer.
- 17 Section 10. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by
- 18 adding Section 5-47 as follows:

- Sec. 5-47. Proton beam therapy; managed care.
- 21 Notwithstanding any other provision of this Article, a managed
- 22 care organization under contract with the Department to
- 23 provide services to recipients of medical assistance shall
- 24 provide coverage for proton beam therapy. As used in this

- Section, "proton beam therapy" means a type of radiation 1 therapy treatment that utilizes protons as the radiation 2 3 delivery method for the treatment of tumors and cancerous 4 cells. "Radiation therapy treatment" means the delivery of 5 biological effective doses with proton therapy, intensity modulated radiation therapy, brachytherapy, stereotactic body 6 radiation therapy, three-dimensional conformal radiation 7
- 9 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect January 1, 2024.". 10
