1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 3046

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 3046, AS AMENDED,
3 by replacing everything after the enacting clause with the
4 following:

5 "Section 5. The Environmental Protection Act is amended by
6 changing Sections 3.145 and 3.365 as follows:

7 (415 ILCS 5/3.145) (was 415 ILCS 5/3.05)

8 Sec. 3.145. Community water supply. "Community water
9 supply" means a public water supply which serves or is
10 intended to serve at least 15 service connections used by
11 residents or regularly serves at least 25 residents for the
12 purpose of drinking, and which serves or is intended to serve
13 at least 50 service connections or regularly serve at least
14 100 residents for the purpose of general domestic use.

15 "Non-community water supply" means a public water supply
16 that is not a community water supply. The requirements of this

1 Act shall not apply to non-community water supplies.

4 Sec. 3.365. Public water supply. "Public water supply"
5 means all mains, pipes and structures through which water is
6 obtained and distributed to the public, including wells and
7 well structures, intakes and cribs, pumping stations,
8 treatment plants, reservoirs, storage tanks and appurtenances,
9 collectively or severally, actually used or intended for use
10 for the purpose of furnishing water for drinking ~~or general~~
11 ~~domestic~~ use and which serve at least 15 service connections
12 or which regularly serve at least 25 persons at least 60 days
13 per year. "Public water supply" also means all mains, pipes,
14 and structures through which water is obtained and distributed
15 to the public, including wells and well structures, intakes
16 and cribs, pumping stations, treatment plants, reservoirs,
17 storage tanks and appurtenances, collectively or severally,
18 actually used or intended for use for the purpose of
19 furnishing water for general domestic use and which serve at
20 least 50 service connections or which regularly serve at least
21 100 persons at least 120 days per year. A public water supply
22 is either a "community water supply" or a "non-community water
23 supply".
