1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 3648

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend House Bill 3648 on page 3, by  
3 replacing lines 5 through 17 with the following:

4 "(d) To facilitate the collection of information on higher  
5 education in prison (HEP) programs, each 4-year public or  
6 private institution of higher education with HEP degree or  
7 certificate programs shall provide the Board of Higher  
8 Education with student-level information as part of its  
9 regular agency data-collection processes. Each public  
10 community college with HEP degree or certificate programs  
11 shall provide the Illinois Community College Board with  
12 student-level information as part of its regular agency  
13 data-collection processes. Upon request, the student-level  
14 information shall include the correctional facility in which  
15 the HEP program is being offered. The information provided to  
16 the Board of Higher Education and the Illinois Community  
17 College Board shall include HEP enrollment and completion data  
18 disaggregated by variables, including but not limited to,

1 race, ethnicity, gender, age, and type of degree or  
2 certificate. The Board of Higher Education and the Illinois  
3 Community College Board shall annually make HEP program data  
4 publicly available on their Internet websites."
