1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 689

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 689 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:"

4 Section 5. The Illinois Local Library Act is amended by
5 adding Section 1-8 as follows:

6 (75 ILCS 5/1-8 new)

7 Sec. 1-8. Book bans prohibited. The board of trustees or
8 staff of a public library established under this Act shall not
9 limit access to biographies, autobiographies, memoirs, or any
10 other books or materials in the library or prohibit the
11 purchase for the library's collection of biographies,
12 autobiographies, memoirs, or any other books or materials
13 based upon the depiction in those books or materials of
14 matters of race, ethnicity, sexual orientation, sexual and
15 reproductive health, gender identity, religion, human rights
16 activism, or any other subject. This Section does not restrict

1 the board of trustees or staff of a public library established
2 under this Act from imposing limitations on access to books or
3 materials in the library for public safety reasons or based
4 upon the age and developmental level of persons who will have
5 access to those books or materials.

6 Section 10. The Illinois Library System Act is amended by
7 changing Section 3 as follows:

8 (75 ILCS 10/3) (from Ch. 81, par. 113)

9 Sec. 3. The State Librarian and his or her staff shall
10 administer the provisions of this Act and shall prescribe such
11 rules and regulations as are necessary to carry the provisions
12 of this Act into effect.

13 The rules and regulations established by the State
14 Librarian for the administration of this Act shall be designed
15 to achieve the following standards and objectives:

16 (A) provide library service for every citizen in the state
17 by extending library facilities to areas not now served;~~i-~~

18 (B) provide library materials for student needs at every
19 educational level;~~i-~~

20 (C) provide adequate library materials to satisfy the
21 reference and research needs of the people of this state;~~i-~~

22 (D) provide an adequate staff of professionally trained
23 librarians for the state;~~i-~~

24 (E) provide an adequate stock of books and other materials

1 sufficient in size and varied in kind and subject matter to
2 satisfy the library needs of the people of this state;~~;~~

3 (F) provide adequate library outlets and facilities
4 convenient in time and place to serve the people of this
5 state;~~;~~

6 (G) encourage existing and new libraries to develop
7 library systems serving a sufficiently large population to
8 support adequate library service at reasonable cost;~~;~~

9 (H) foster the economic and efficient utilization of
10 public funds;~~;~~

11 (I) promote the full utilization of local pride,
12 responsibility, initiative and support of library service and
13 at the same time employ state aid as a supplement to local
14 support; ~~and;~~

15 (J) prohibit the library systems established under this
16 Act and their staff from limiting access to biographies,
17 autobiographies, memoirs, or any other books or materials and
18 prohibit the purchase of biographies, autobiographies,
19 memoirs, or any other books or materials based upon the
20 depiction in those books or materials of matters of race,
21 ethnicity, sexual orientation, gender identity, religion,
22 human rights activism, or any other subject. This paragraph
23 (J) does not restrict a library system or its staff from
24 imposing limitations on access to books or materials in the
25 library system for public safety reasons or based upon the age
26 and developmental level of persons who will have access to

1 those books or materials.

2 The Advisory Committee of the Illinois State Library shall
3 confer with, advise and make recommendations to the State
4 Librarian regarding any matter under this Act and particularly
5 with reference to the formation of library systems.

7 Section 15. The Public Library District Act of 1991 is
8 amended by adding Section 1-60 as follows:

9 (75 ILCS 16/1-60 new)

10 Sec. 1-60. Book bans prohibited. The board of trustees or
11 staff of a library established under this Act shall not limit
12 access to biographies, autobiographies, memoirs, or any other
13 books or materials in the library or prohibit the purchase for
14 the library's collection of biographies, autobiographies,
15 memoirs, or any other books or materials based upon the
16 depiction in those materials of matters of race, ethnicity,
17 sexual orientation, sexual and reproductive health, gender
18 identity, religion, human rights activism, or any other
19 subject. This Section does not restrict the board of trustees
20 or staff of a library established under this Act from imposing
21 limitations on access to books or materials in the library for
22 public safety reasons or based upon the age and developmental
23 level of persons who will have access to those books or
24 materials.

1 Section 20. The Village Library Act is amended by adding
2 Section 6 as follows:

3 (75 ILCS 40/6 new)

4 Sec. 6. Book bans prohibited. The board of trustees or
5 staff of a village library established under this Act shall
6 not limit access to biographies, autobiographies, memoirs, or
7 any other books or materials in the library or prohibit the
8 purchase for the village library's collection of biographies,
9 autobiographies, memoirs, or any other books or materials
10 based upon the depiction in those materials of matters of
11 race, ethnicity, sexual orientation, sexual and reproductive
12 health, gender identity, religion, human rights activism, or
13 any other subject. This Section does not restrict the board of
14 trustees of a village library established under this Act from
15 imposing limitations on access to books or materials in the
16 village library for public safety reasons or based upon the
17 age and developmental level of persons who will have access to
18 those books or materials.

19 Section 25. The School Code is amended by by adding
20 Sections 10-20.85 and 34-18.82 as follows:

21 (105 ILCS 5/10-20.85 new)

22 Sec. 10-20.85. Book bans prohibited. Neither a school

1 district nor its staff shall limit access to biographies,
2 autobiographies, memoirs, or any other books or materials in a
3 school library or prohibit the purchase for the school
4 library's collection of biographies, autobiographies, memoirs,
5 or any other books or materials based upon the depiction in
6 those materials of matters of race, ethnicity, sexual
7 orientation, sexual and reproductive health, gender identity,
8 religion, human rights activism, or any other subject. This
9 Section does not restrict a school district or its staff from
10 imposing limitations on access to books or materials in a
11 school library for public safety reasons or based upon the age
12 and developmental level of students who will have access to
13 those books or materials.

14 (105 ILCS 5/34-18.82 new)

15 Sec. 34-18.82. Book bans prohibited. Neither the school
16 district nor its staff shall limit access to biographies,
17 autobiographies, memoirs, or any other books or materials in a
18 school library or prohibit the purchase for the school
19 library's collection of biographies, autobiographies, memoirs,
20 or any other books or materials based upon the depiction in
21 those materials of matters of race, ethnicity, sexual
22 orientation, sexual and reproductive health, gender identity,
23 religion, human rights activism, or any other subject. This
24 Section does not restrict the school district or its staff
25 from imposing limitations on access to books or materials in a

1 school library for public safety reasons or based upon the age
2 and developmental level of students who will have access to
3 those books or materials."
