SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

New Act
30 ILCS 805/8.47 new

Creates the Government Zero Emission Vehicle Act. Defines terms. Provides that all vehicles owned by a governmental unit must either be a manufactured zero-emission vehicle or converted into a zero-emission vehicle no later than January 1, 2045. Requires the Environmental Protection Agency to adopt rules to implement the Act. Provides that the rules may include requirements for all governmental units to gradually reduce the percentage of vehicles that are not zero-emission vehicles up through January 1, 2045. Limits the concurrent exercise of home rule powers. Amends the State Mandates Act to require implementation without reimbursement.

STATE MANDATES

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning government.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the
5 Government Zero Emission Vehicle Act.

6 Section 5. Definitions. As used in this Act:

7 "Agency" means the Environmental Protection Agency.

8 "Governmental unit" means the State, a State agency, a
9 unit of local government, or any other political subdivision
10 of the State.

11 "Zero-emission vehicle" means a passenger or commercial
12 motor vehicle that produces zero exhaust emissions of any
13 criteria pollutant, precursor pollutant, or greenhouse gas,
14 but only produces water vapor, in any mode of operation or
15 condition, as determined by the Agency.

16 Section 10. Zero-emission vehicles of governmental units.
17 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, all vehicles owned
18 by a governmental unit must either be a manufactured
19 zero-emission vehicle or converted into a zero-emission
20 vehicle no later than January 1, 2045.

21 Section 15. Rules. The Environmental Protection Agency

1 must adopt rules to implement this Act. The rules may include
2 requirements for a governmental unit to gradually reduce the
3 percentage of vehicles that are not zero-emission vehicles up
4 through January 1, 2045.

5 Section 90. Home rule. A home rule unit may not regulate
6 the unit's vehicles in a manner inconsistent with this Act.
7 This Act is a limitation under subsection (i) of Section 6 of
8 Article VII of the Illinois Constitution on the concurrent
9 exercise by home rule units of powers and functions exercised
10 by the State.

11 Section 99. The State Mandates Act is amended by adding
12 Section 8.47 as follows:

13 (30 ILCS 805/8.47 new)

14 Sec. 8.47. Exempt mandate. Notwithstanding Sections 6 and
15 8 of this Act, no reimbursement by the State is required for
16 the implementation of any mandate created by this amendatory
17 Act of the 103rd General Assembly.
