1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 3599

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 3599 on page 7, by
3 replacing lines 19 through 24 with the following:

4 "services.

5 (a) In this Section:

6 "Eligible recipient" means an individual who has received
7 hospital emergency department services 3 or more times in a
8 period of 4 consecutive months in the past 12 months or an
9 individual who has been identified by a health care provider
10 as an individual for whom mobile integrated health care
11 services would likely prevent admission or readmission to or
12 would allow discharge from a hospital, behavioral health
13 facility, acute care facility, or nursing facility.

14 "Mobile integrated health care services" means medically
15 necessary health services provided on-site by emergency
16 medical services personnel, as defined in Section 5 of the
17 Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Systems Act.

18 "Mobile integrated health care services" includes health

1 assessment, chronic disease monitoring and education,
2 medication compliance, immunizations and vaccinations,
3 laboratory specimen collection, hospital discharge follow-up
4 care, and minor medical procedures as approved by the
5 applicable EMS Medical Director.

6 "Mobile integrated health care services" does not include
7 nonemergency ambulance transport.

8 (b) A group or individual policy of accident and health
9 insurance or a managed care plan that is amended, delivered,
10 issued, or renewed on or after January 1, 2026, shall provide
11 coverage to an eligible recipient for medically necessary
12 mobile integrated health care services."
