#### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

405 ILCS 5/Ch. IV Art. VIII heading new  
405 ILCS 5/4-800 new

Amends the Mental Health and Developmental Disabilities Code. Provides that the Division of Developmental Disabilities of the Department of Human Services may impose progressive sanctions, excluding a situation in which a recipient of services is placed at immediate risk of harm, on providers that fail to comply with conditions specified by rule, contract, or policy as determined by the Division. Provides that sanctions include, but are not limited to, payment suspension, loss of payment, enrollment limitations including admission holds, or other actions up to and including contract termination. Provides that a service provider receiving a sanction may appeal the sanction in writing to the Department of Healthcare and Family Services within 30 days after receipt of the sanction.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Mental Health and Developmental  
5 Disabilities Code is amended by adding Article VIII to Chapter  
6 IV as follows:

8 ARTICLE VIII. SERVICE PROVIDER SANCTIONS

10 Sec. 4-800. Progressive sanctions. The Division of  
11 Developmental Disabilities of the Department of Human Services  
12 may impose progressive sanctions, excluding a situation in  
13 which a recipient of services is placed at immediate risk of  
14 harm, on providers that fail to comply with conditions  
15 specified by rule, contract, or policy as determined by the  
16 Division. Sanctions include, but are not limited to, payment  
17 suspension, loss of payment, enrollment limitations including  
18 admission holds, or other actions up to and including contract  
19 termination. A service provider receiving a sanction may  
20 appeal the sanction in writing to the Department of Healthcare  
21 and Family Services within 30 days after receipt of the  
22 sanction.
