WHEREAS, Alice McCart moved around the country while she was young, living in Michigan, Texas, and Iowa due to her father's job as a recruiter for the U.S. Army; and

WHEREAS, Alice McCart earned double Bachelors of Arts in German and French at the University of Kansas in 1969, later returning to earn a Master of Arts in Teaching and German in 1971 and a master's degree in journalism in 1983; and

WHEREAS, Alice McCart married Robert McBride in 1969, and they had three children, Elizabeth, Mark, and Maggie; and

WHEREAS, Alice McCart worked at the U.S. Army Command and General Staff College at Fort Leavenworth, where she translated German and French, was a production editor for Military Review magazine, and served as an English teacher for

3 the Healthcare Financial Management Association; and

4 WHEREAS, Alice McCart began studying to earn her Juris  
5 Doctor from the Chicago-Kent College of Law in 1993; after

7 Chicago; and

8 WHEREAS, Alice McCart then became the managing editor for  
9 the American Health Lawyers Association and the American  
10 Corporate Counsel Association publications; and

11 WHEREAS, Alice McCart moved back to Kansas, where she  
12 became one of the nation's leading experts in HIPAA compliance  
13 and other healthcare-related privacy law and electronic health  
14 information standardization; and
