

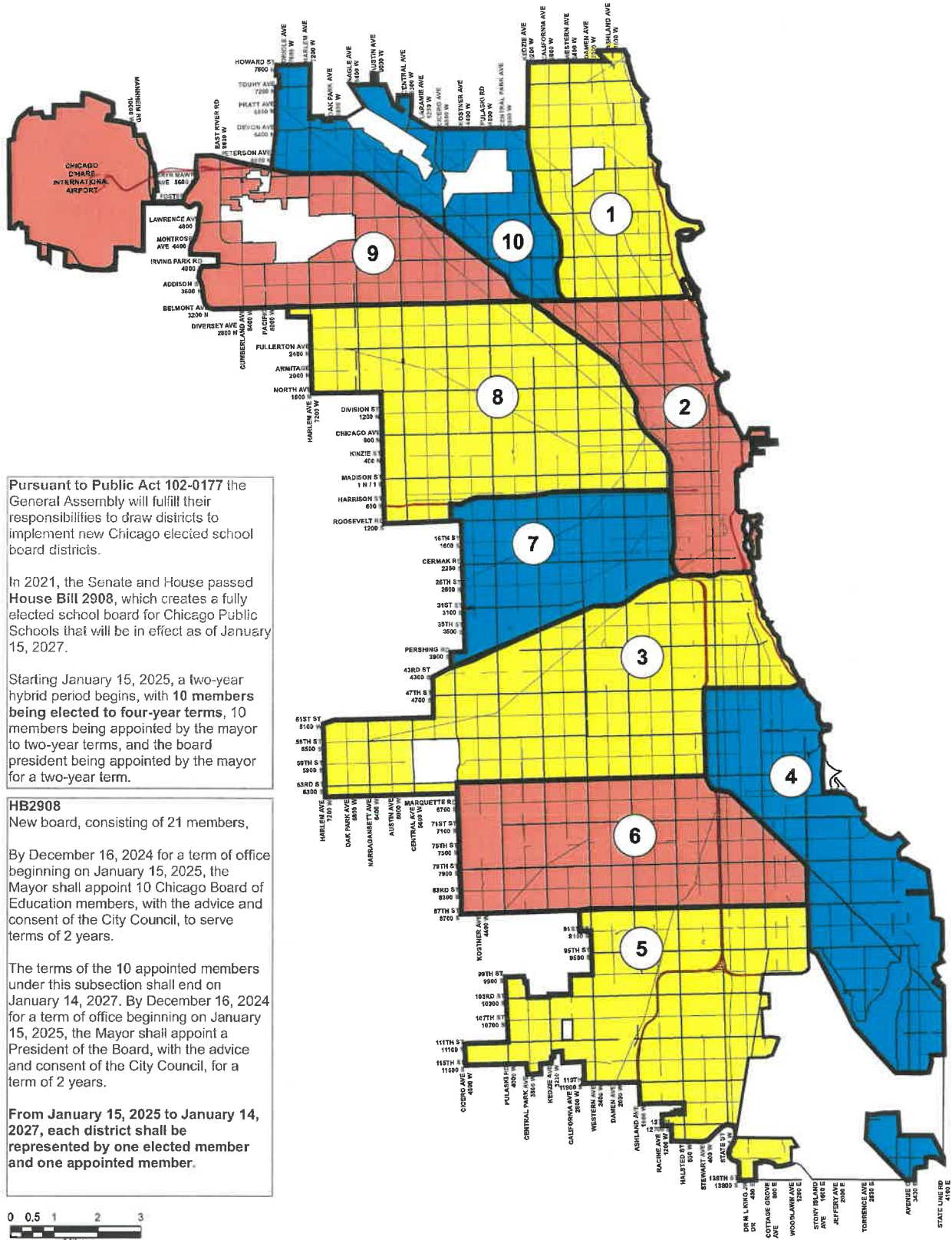

Pursuant to Public Act 102-0177 the General Assembly will fulfill their responsibilities to draw districts to implement new Chicago elected school board districts.

In 2021, the Senate and House passed House Bill 2908, which creates a fully elected school board for Chicago Public Schools that will be in effect as of January 15, 2027.

Starting January 15, 2025, a two-year hybrid period begins, with 10 members being elected to four-year terms, 10 members being appointed by the mayor to two-year terms, and the board president being appointed by the mayor for a two-year term.

New board, consisting of 21 members,
By December 16, 2024 for a term of office beginning on January 15, 2025, the Mayor shall appoint 10 Chicago Board of Education members, with the advice and consent of the City Council, to serve terms of 2 years.

The terms of the 10 appointed members under this subsection shall end on January 14, 2027. By December 16, 2024 for a term of office beginning on January 15, 2025, the Mayor shall appoint a President of the Board, with the advice and consent of the City Council, for a term of 2 years.

From January 15, 2025 to January 14, 2027, each district shall be represented by one elected member and one appointed member.
