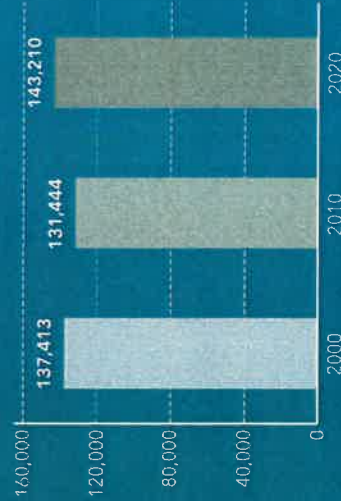

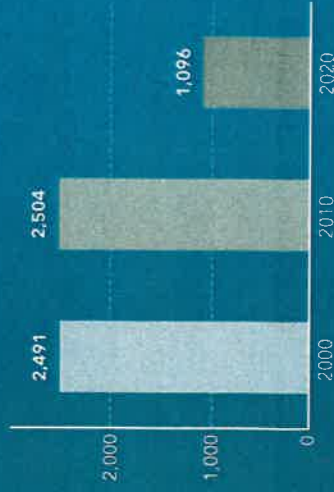

HOUSEHOLD POPULATION



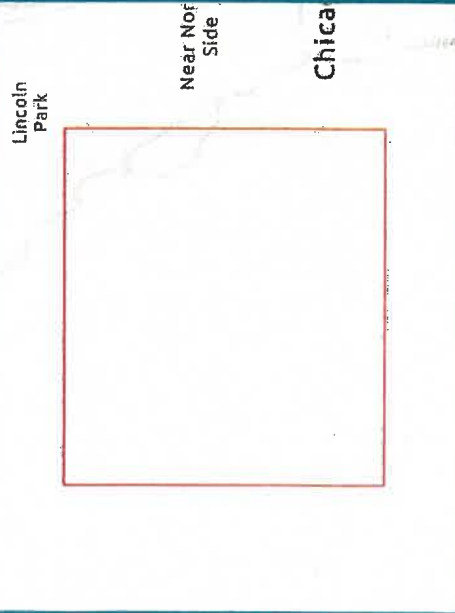

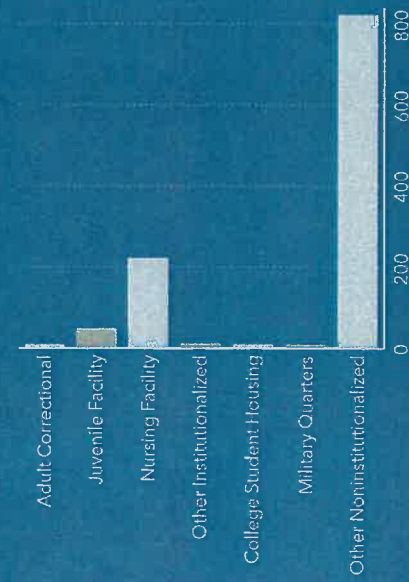
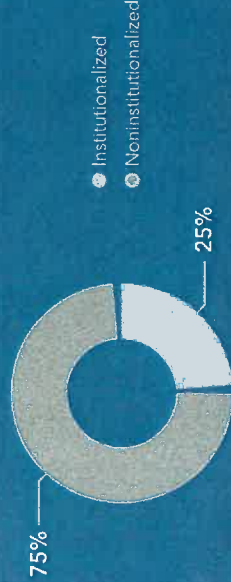
