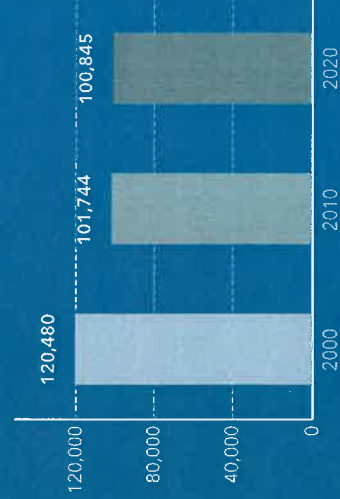

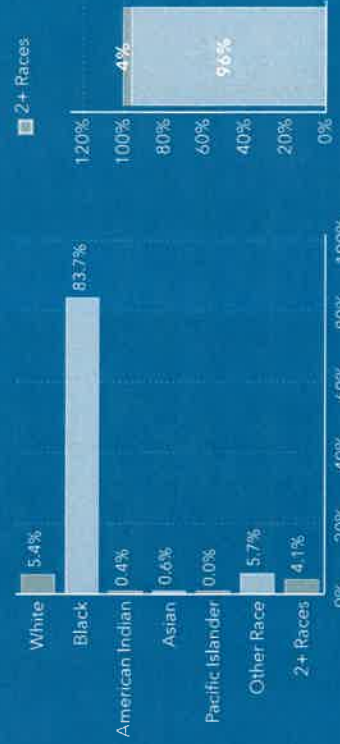

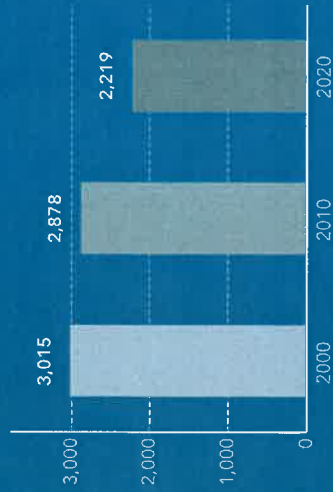
HOUSEHOLD POPULATION



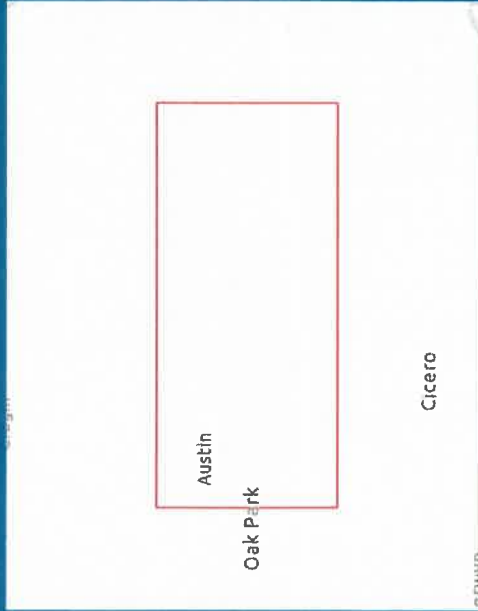
TOTAL POPULATION BY RACE

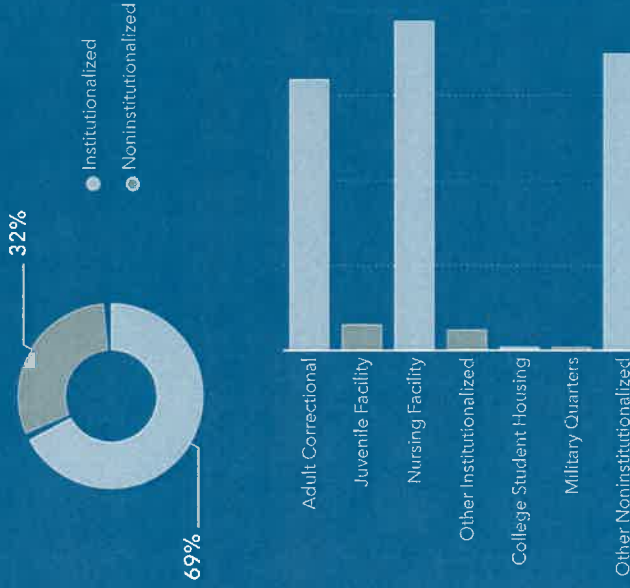
