Please be advised that, while this letter is not a subpoena, the Committee reserves the right to issue a subpoena for your sworn testimony should you choose not to voluntarily testify. Please also understand that, because this House inquiry is not a criminal proceeding, the Members may draw an adverse inference from your refusal to testify.
