Pursuant to Rule 60(b), I move to table HOUSE BILL 159.

RECESS

SENATE BILL ON SECOND READING

SENATE BILL 9. Having been read by title a second time on May 29, 2017, and held on the order of Second Reading, the same was again taken up.

Floor Amendments numbered 1 and 2 remained in the Committee on Rules.

Representative Greg Harris offered Amendment No. 3 and moved its adoption.

And on that motion, a vote was taken resulting as follows:

65, Yeas; 48, Nays; 0, Answering Present.

(ROLL CALL 2)

The foregoing motion prevailed and the amendment was adopted.

There being no further amendment(s), the bill, as amended, was advanced to the order of Third Reading.

SENATE BILL ON THIRD READING

The following bill and any amendments adopted thereto were reproduced. Any amendments still pending upon the passage or defeat of a bill on Third Reading are automatically tabled pursuant to Rule 40(a).

On motion of Representative Davis, SENATE BILL 9 was taken up and read by title a third time. A three-fifths vote is required.

And the question being, “Shall this bill pass?” it was decided in the affirmative by the following vote:

72, Yeas; 45, Nays; 0, Answering Present.

(ROLL CALL 3)

This bill, as amended, having received the votes of three-fifths of the Members elected, was declared passed.

Ordered that the Clerk inform the Senate thereof and ask their concurrence in the House amendment/s adopted thereto.

SENATE BILL ON SECOND READING

SENATE BILL 6. Having been read by title a second time on June 30, 2017, and held on the order of Second Reading, the same was again taken up.

Representative Greg Harris offered and withdrew Amendment No. 1.

Floor Amendment No. 2 remained in the Committee on Rules.

Representative Greg Harris offered Amendments numbered 3 and 4 and moved their adoption.

The foregoing motions prevailed and the amendments were adopted.

There being no further amendment(s), the bill, as amended, was advanced to the order of Third Reading.

SENATE BILL ON THIRD READING

The following bill and any amendments adopted thereto were reproduced. Any amendments still pending upon the passage or defeat of a bill on Third Reading are automatically tabled pursuant to Rule 40(a).

On motion of Representative Greg Harris, SENATE BILL 6 was taken up and read by title a third time. A three-fifths vote is required.

And the question being, "Shall this bill pass?" it was decided in the affirmative by the following vote:

81, Yeas; 34, Nays; 0, Answering Present.

(ROLL CALL 4)

This bill, as amended, having received the votes of three-fifths of the Members elected, was declared passed.

Ordered that the Clerk inform the Senate thereof and ask their concurrence in the House amendment/s adopted thereto.

At the hour of 7:53 o'clock p.m., Representative Currie moved that the House do now adjourn until Monday, July 3, 2017, at 10:00 o'clock a.m., allowing perfunctory time for the Clerk.

The motion prevailed.

And the House stood adjourned.
