Mr. Speaker -- I am directed to inform the House of Representatives that the Senate has adopted the following Senate Joint Resolution, in the adoption of which I am instructed to ask the concurrence of the House of Representatives, to-wit:

#### **SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 46**

RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDREDTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING HEREIN, that when the Senate adjourns regular session, as well as special sessions 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10, the Senate shall remain in continuous session and it stands adjourned until the call of the President; and when the House of Representatives adjourns regular session, as well as special session 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10, the House of Representatives shall remain in continuous session and it stands adjourned until the call of the Speaker.

Adopted by the Senate, July 4, 2017.

The Motion, having received the votes of three-fifths of the Members elected, prevailed and the House does concur with the Senate in the passage of the bill, the Veto of the Governor notwithstanding.

Ordered that the Clerk inform the Senate.

Pursuant to the Motion submitted previously, Representative Greg Harris moved that the House concur with the Senate in the passage of SENATE BILL 6, the Veto of the Governor notwithstanding. A three-fifths vote is required.

And on that motion, a vote was taken resulting as follows:

74, Yeas; 37, Nays; 0, Answering Present.

(ROLL CALL 4)

The Motion, having received the votes of three-fifths of the Members elected, prevailed and the House does concur with the Senate in the passage of the bill, the Veto of the Governor notwithstanding.

Ordered that the Clerk inform the Senate.
