Dear Chairman Welch:

On February 4, 2020, I filed with the House Clerk a House Qualifications Challenge Petition against then newly-appointed State Representative Eva-Dina Delgado. This resulted in the formation of a House Qualifications Challenge Committee, per the House Rules. On February 27, 2020, I filed an Amended Qualification Challenge Petition.

I am sending this letter withdrawing both my initial petition and amended petition. As we approach the end of the 101st General Assembly and the beginning of the 102nd General Assembly next month, it is time to move forward and thus I withdraw my petitions. Since I filed the two petitions, Representative Delgado was chosen to be her party's nominee in the primary and was elected to the position in the recent November election. The voters of her district have spoken and chosen her to be their elected State Representative. Accordingly, I consider the issue before the committee moot.

Under House Rule 87(b), the Committee may dismiss a qualifications challenge. Should the Committee meet again before the end of the 101st General Assembly, I would ask that the Committee dismiss the qualifications challenge that was initiated by my petitions.

In addition, I request that this letter be included as part of the complete record of the proceedings, and also be entered into the House Journal.
