WHEREAS, the Census Bureau reports that there are 41 million Americans who are uninsured and more than 8 million of them are children; and

WHEREAS, nearly eight out of 10 uninsured people are in working families; and

WHEREAS, most people who are uninsured are employed but cannot afford health insurance. These individuals are most likely to be self-employed, contractors, part-time workers, employees of small firms and employees in service-orientated professions; and

WHEREAS, Cover the Uninsured Week will feature hundreds of grassroots events held in communities across the United States; and

WHEREAS, Cover the Uninsured Week is an unprecedented campaign to raise awareness of this pressing issue; and

WHEREAS, earlier this year, with support from The Robert Wood Johnson Foundation (RWJF), these groups announced a \$10 million advertising campaign and an educational website dedicated to the issues;

THEREFORE, I, Rod Blagojevich, Governor of the State of Illinois, proclaim March 10-16, 2003, as COVER THE UNINSURED WEEK in Illinois.
