PROCLAMATION

04-182

WHEREAS, the Illinois Constitution requires the General Assembly to make appropriations for the expenditure of public funds for the fiscal year for State departments, authorities, and public agencies; and

WHEREAS, the General Assembly has not made appropriations for fiscal year 2005 for the expenditure of public funds for the Department of Military Affairs, Illinois Emergency Management Agency, Department of Corrections, Department of State Police, Department of Children and Family Services, Department of Public Aid, Department of Public Health and the Department of Human Services; and

THEREFORE, pursuant to Article IV, Section 5 (b) of the Illinois Constitution of 1970, I hereby call and convene the 93rd General Assembly in a special session to commence on June 24, 2004, at 2:00 p.m., to consider Senate Bills 3232, 3233, 3241, 3242, 3243, 3256, and 3278 and any other legislation (new or pending), which will address directly the budget of the Department of Military Affairs, Illinois Emergency Management Agency, Department of Corrections, Department of State Police, Department of Children and Family Services, Department of Public Aid, Department of Public Health and the Department of Human Services for fiscal year 2005.
