Speaker of the House Madigan in the chair.

Speaker of the House Madigan asks leave to use the Quorum Roll Call from the First Special Session to convene the Fourth Special Session.

Leave was granted.

Representative Hoffman makes a point of order regarding the time of convening the 4<sup>th</sup> Special Session before 2:30 o'clock p.m.

The Speaker of the House Madigan rules that it is in order to convene before 2:30 o'clock p.m.

### **ACTION ON MOTIONS**

Representative Currie moved for the immediate consideration and suspension of applicable House Rules for the adoptions of House Resolutions 1 and 2.

A voice vote was taken on the motion.

The motion prevailed.

### **RESOLUTIONS**

Representative Currie offered the following Resolutions:

#### **HOUSE RESOLUTION 1 FOURTH SPECIAL SESSION**

**RESOLVED**, that the Rules of the House of Representatives of the Ninety-Fifth General Assembly be adopted as the Rules of this Fourth Special Session, so far as the same may be applicable, and that the Committees of the House of Representatives of the Ninety-Fifth General Assembly, including the House Journal Review Committee and their membership, shall constitute the Committees of the House during this Fourth Special Session.

#### **HOUSE RESOLUTION 2 FOURTH SPECIAL SESSION**

**RESOLVED**, that the Clerk inform the Senate that a majority of the House of Representatives has assembled, pursuant to the proclamation of the Governor, convening a Fourth Special Session of the General Assembly, and are now ready for the transaction of business.

The motion prevailed and House Resolutions 1 and 2 were adopted.

### **PROCLAMATION**

**07-234**

WHEREAS, the Illinois Constitution requires the General Assembly to make appropriations for the expenditure of public funds for the fiscal year for State departments, authorities, and public agencies; and

WHEREAS, the General Assembly has not made appropriations for fiscal year 2008 for the expenditure of public funds for the Child Support Administrative Fund within the Department of Healthcare and Family Services; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Healthcare and Family Services is charged with the collection and disbursement of child support payments; and

WHEREAS, child support is the second largest income source for low-income families who qualify for the program;

THEREFORE, pursuant to Article IV, Section 5 (b) of the Illinois Constitution of 1970, I hereby call and

convene the 95<sup>th</sup> General Assembly in a special session to commence on July 7, 2007, at 2:30 p.m., to consider any legislation, new or pending, which will address the budget of the Department of Healthcare and Family Services for the Child Support Administrative Fund for fiscal year 2008.
