The following bill was introduced, read by title a first time, ordered reproduced and placed in the Committee on Rules:

HOUSE BILL 4124. Introduced by Representative Saviano, AN ACT concerning revenue.

HOUSE RESOLUTION

The following resolution was offered and placed in the Committee on Rules.

HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION 75

Offered by Representative Washington:

WHEREAS, Bobby E. Thompson has been a political figure in the Lake County area for 18 years and was the first African American mayor in the county, having served as mayor of North Chicago; and

WHEREAS, The portion of Illinois State Route 137 in Waukegan lying between Greenwood Avenue and Sheridan Road/McKinley Avenue is now known as the Amstutz Expressway; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETY-FIFTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, THE SENATE CONCURRING HEREIN, that the Amstutz Expressway be renamed the Bobby E. Thompson Expressway; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Illinois Department of Transportation is requested to erect at suitable locations, consistent with State regulations, plaques or signs giving notice of the name; and be it further

RESOLVED, That suitable copies of this resolution be presented to the Illinois Secretary of Transportation and to former North Chicago Mayor Bobby E. Thompson.

AGREED RESOLUTION

The following resolution was offered and placed on the Calendar on the order of Agreed Resolutions.

Offered by Representative Schock:
Mourns the death of General Wayne Downing of Peoria.

RECALL

At the request of the principal sponsor, Representative Saviano, HOUSE BILL 127 was recalled from the order of Third Reading to the order of Second Reading.

HOUSE BILL ON SECOND READING

HOUSE BILL 127. Having been recalled on July 23, 2007, the same was again taken up.

Representative Saviano offered and withdrew Amendment No. 1.

Representative Saviano offered the following amendment and moved its adoption.

AMENDMENT NO. 2. Amend House Bill 127 immediately below the enacting clause, by inserting the following:

"Section 3. If and only if Senate Bill 448 of the 95th General Assembly becomes law, then "An Act concerning regulation" (Senate Bill 448 of the 95th General Assembly) is amended by adding Section 99 as follows:

(S.B. 448, 95th G.A., Sec. 99 new)

Sec. 99. This Act (Senate Bill 448 of the 95th General Assembly) takes effect on the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 95th General Assembly (House Bill 127 of the 95th General Assembly).

Section 4. If and only if House Bill 1947 of the 95th General Assembly becomes law, then "An Act concerning regulation" (House Bill 1947 of the 95th General Assembly) is amended by adding Section 99 as follows:

(H.B. 1947, 95th G.A., Sec. 99 new)

Sec. 99. This Act (House Bill 1947 of the 95th General Assembly) takes effect on the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 95th General Assembly (House Bill 127 of the 95th General Assembly)."

The foregoing motion prevailed and Amendment No. 2 was adopted.

There being no further amendments, the foregoing Amendment No. 2 was ordered engrossed; and the bill, as amended, was again advanced to the order of Third Reading.

RECALL

At the request of the principal sponsor, Representative Scully, SENATE BILL 1592 was recalled from the order of Third Reading to the order of Second Reading and held on that order.

AGREED RESOLUTION

HOUSE RESOLUTION 616 was taken up for consideration.
Representative Schock moved the adoption of the agreed resolution.
