**CONCURRENCES AND NON-CONCURRENCES

### **AGREED RESOLUTIONS**

HOUSE RESOLUTIONS 580, 581, 582, 583 and 584 were taken up for consideration.

### **HOUSE BILL ON SECOND READING**

HOUSE BILL 690. Having been read by title a second time on April 24, 2015, and held on the order of Second Reading, the same was again taken up.

Representative Franks offered Amendment No. 1 and moved its adoption.

And on that motion, a vote was taken resulting as follows:

43, Yeas; 18, Nays; 34, Answering Present.

(ROLL CALL 3)

The foregoing motion prevailed and Amendment No. 1 was adopted.

There being no further amendments, the foregoing Amendment No. 1 was ordered engrossed; and the bill, as amended, was advanced to the order of Third Reading.

### **HOUSE BILL ON THIRD READING**

The following bill and any amendments adopted thereto were reproduced. This bill has been examined, any amendments thereto engrossed and any errors corrected. Any amendments still pending upon the passage or defeat of a bill on Third Reading are automatically tabled pursuant to Rule 40(a).

On motion of Representative Franks, HOUSE BILL 690 was taken up and read by title a third time.

Representative Sandack was recognized for a parliamentary inquiry regarding the applicability of extraordinary vote requirements for certain limitations on home rule units of local government.

The Chair ruled that a vote of three-fifths of the members elected (71 votes) was required for the passage of the bill.

And the question being, "Shall this bill pass?" it was decided in the negative by the following vote:

41, Yeas; 23, Nays; 34, Answering Present.

(ROLL CALL 4)

This bill, having failed to receive the votes of three-fifths of the Members elected, was declared lost.

### **HOUSE BILL ON SECOND READING**

HOUSE BILL 691. Having been read by title a second time on April 24, 2015, and held on the order of Second Reading, the same was again taken up.

Representative Bradley offered Amendment No. 1 and moved its adoption.

And on that motion, a vote was taken resulting as follows:

44, Yeas; 21, Nays; 33, Answering Present.

(ROLL CALL 5)

The foregoing motion prevailed and Amendment No. 1 was adopted.

Representative Bradley offered Amendment No. 2 and moved its adoption.

And on that motion, a vote was taken resulting as follows:

0, Yeas; 69, Nays; 26, Answering Present.

(ROLL CALL 6)

The motion was lost.

There being no further amendments, the foregoing Amendment No. 1 was ordered engrossed; and the bill, as amended, was advanced to the order of Third Reading.

At the hour of 3:48 o'clock p.m., Representative Currie moved that the House do now adjourn, allowing perfunctory time for the Clerk.

The motion prevailed.

And in accordance therewith and pursuant to HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION 85, the House stood adjourned.
