Speaker Lang: "The Thirteenth Special Session of the House will come to order. With leave of the Body we'll use the quorum Roll Call from the Fourteenth Special Session for the quorum Roll Call for the Thirteenth Special Session. Is there leave? Leave is granted. Mr. Clerk, Adjournment Resolution."

Clerk Hollman: "Thirteenth Special Session House Joint Resolution #1, offered by Currie.

RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE HUNDREDTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, AT THE THIRTEENTH SPECIAL SESSION THEREOF, THE SENATE CONCURRING HEREIN, that when the House of Representatives and Senate adjourns on July 31, 2017, the House shall remain in continuous session and stands adjourned until the call of the Speaker, and the Senate shall remain in continuous session and stands adjourned to the call of the President."

Lang: "Ladies and Gentlemen I have been asked to announce a Republican Caucus in Room 118 upon adjournment. Leader Currie moves for the adoption of the Adjournment Resolution. Those in favor say 'yes'; opposed 'no'. The 'ayes' have it. And the Resolution is adopted. Leader Currie now moves that the Thirteenth Special Session adjourn until the call of the Speaker. Those in favor say 'yes'; opposed 'no'. The 'ayes' have it and the Resolution is adopted and the House is adjourned."
