Secretary Howlett: "The Clerk will read a resolution. The resolution is in French and I don't know who is going to read it."

Fred Selcke: "House Joint Resolution No. 1. Beaupre, et al. Whereas more than seven score and four years, Francois Bourbonnais, the French courier DuBois, was one of the first white men to arrive in the Potawatamee village within the wooded and fertile valley along the Kankakee River, and whereas in 1832, Noel Laveseur, a young French-Canadian adventurer, established a trading post in that community and married Princess Watseka, daughter of the Potawatamee Chief, whose parents had moved to Iowa pursuant to a treaty between the Indians and the United States of America, and whereas in 1837, as the result of favorable reports of the locality by Noel Laveseur, families from Canada arrived in the community, which by then was called Bourbonnais grove, and



in the same year, Father Gralamier, a missionary from Vincennes, Indiana, celebrated the first Roman Catholic mass in the County, which event took place in the home of Noel Leveseur on the corner of Main Avenue and Marseilles Street, and whereas in 1841, as more settlers arrived from Quebec Province, Canada, the local residents erected a log chapel on the site where the present Maternity Church Rectory now stands. And whereas where the Indian summer of 1853, the newly constructed parish church was destroyed by fire, the origin of which became the subject of suits and countersuits in which the then obscure lawyer, Abraham Lincoln, was involved. And whereas, after five years of toil and tears and the extreme difficulties encountered by the faithful parishners, first in extractin the huge stone slab from neighboring quarries, and then transporting them by teams of oxen over often impassable roads, the new Maternity B.V.M. Church was finally dedicated in 1858. But the cathedral high peak that had been planned for the church was somewhat curtailed. And whereas, in 1860 at the invitation of Father Alexis Malos, the Sisters of Congregation of Notre Dame in Montreal, Canada arrived and assumed direction of the community school. And whereas, in 1865 two conferees arrived subsequently established St. Vidar College and undertook the teaching of the boys in the settlement. And whereas long after the last of the Potawatamee Indians had left for new hunting grounds, in Iowa, the residents of the community decided to establish a formal government. And whereas, after several years discussion, a formal petition was presented to the County Court of Kankakee County, a referendum was called, and on April 13, 1875, an election revealed 39 votes cast in favor of incorporation as a village, and a lone dissent. And whereas, on May 11, 1875 the voter of Bourbonnais Grove elected the first Board of Trustees, and two days later, May 13, 1875, County Judge Starr declared Bourbonnais an official village and the community was finally incorporated.

George Laterno became its first Mayor. And whereas, the pass of time, the pronounciation of Bourbonnais named after Francois Bourbonnais deteriorated until it now became Borbonet. And whereas, on May 13, 1875, the citizens of the Village of Bourbonnais will celebrate the centennial year of its incorporation. And whereas, Bourbonnais as a proud and energetic citizenry has maintained a beautiful place to live and work, always adding to their rich French-Canadian heritage. Therefore, be it resolved by the House of Representatives, the 79th General Assembly, the State of Illinois, the Senate concurring herein, we congratulate the Village of Bourbonnais Illinois, its officials and citizens on the occasion of its centennial celebration of its becoming a village, that we express our sincere wishes for many more achievements in the future by its citizens, who left such a firm foundation in history, and accomplishments, and that we urge all people to pronounce the name of this historic village, Borbene, from this day hence, and be it further resolved that a suitable copy of this Preamble and Resolution be forwarded to the Honorable Ernest Moody, Mayor of the Village of Bourbonnais."

Secretary Howlett: "Representative Beaupre."

Beaupre: "Mr. Secretary, after hearing the Clerk read that resolution and noting the difficulty with the pronounciation of the French names, I think it is clear to everybody why this resolution has been submitted to encourage the correct pronounciation of the Village of Bourbonnais on this, its centennial year. I would move for the adoption of House Senate Joint Resolution 1."

Borchers: "Now we're all equal here, we've got no leadership. Personally, I represent a group of people downstate and I'm sick and tired of foolin around. It is not my nature. Now I want to point out to you and I see that it is hopeless, I was supposed to be on radio an..an hour in Decatur, at 1:15. I'll never make it. This, of course, is your loss and your gain. Take your choice. Now I just have one suggestion. Don't give a damn if you take it or not, by my own leadership, or my own party or the other or either. But I don't think it hurts to have a caucus of the Republican Party, it is just a suggestion. We'll pick out one serious of the 30's or the 40's, and while we Republicans vote as we damn please and we just might shake something loose. Then we'll go back to what we are doing. This gives the other side an idea what we could do if we wanted to. Just one time in the 30's or 40's, a freedom to do as we please. I'm willing to go along with my party of course, because I'd be wrong not to. It is wrong of us not to stick together and show that we can make a point of solidarity. That's alright. 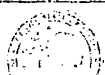
