Clerk O'Brien: "A message from the Senate by Mr. Fernandes, Temporary Clerk. Mr. Speaker, I'm directed to inform the House of Representatives the Senate has adopted the following Senate Joint Resolution in the adoption of which I'm instructed to ask concurrence of the House of Representatives to wit', Senate Joint Resolution #1, 'Resolved by the Senate of the Eightieth General Assembly of the State of Illinois, the House of Representatives concurring herein, that when the two Houses adjourn on Wednesday, January 19, 1977, the Senate stands adjourned until Tuesday, January 25, 1977, at 12 o'clock noon; and the House of Representatives stands adjourned until Tuesday, January 25, 1977, at 2 o'clock p.m., adopted by the Senate, January 19, 1977'. Edward E. Fernandes, Temporary Secretary."

Speaker Redmond: "Representative Bradley moves the adoption of the Adjournment Resolution. All in favor indicate by saying 'aye', 'aye', opposed 'no'; the 'ayes' have it, the Resolution is adopted. The House now stands adjourned until Tuesday, the 25th, at 2 o'clock p.m."
