The right of trial by jury is heretofore enjoyed shall remain inviolate except that the General Assembly, by law, may abolish the right of jury trial for prosecutions of offenses punishable by imprisonment of no more than six months or by a fine of no more than \$500. Schedule. This Amendment of Section 8 and 13 of Article I of the Constitution takes effect on January 1 following its approval by the electors of this State.
