No expense of the State Government from the General Revenue or Common School Funds shall be incurred in any fiscal year which exceed in amount the revenue limit established by this Section. (b) For any fiscal year in the event that revenues to the General Revenue and Common School Funds exceed the revenue limits established in subsection (a) of this Section, this excess

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shall be transferred to the Budget Stabilization Fund in the State Treasury which is hereby created. Emergency expenditures from the Budget Stabilization Fund may be (sic - made) only if all the following conditions are met: 1. The Governor requests the General Assembly to declare an emergency; 2. The request is specific as to the nature of the emergency and the dollar amount of the emergency; and 3. The General Assembly thereafter declares an emergency in accordance with the Governor's request by a Joint Resolution adopted by three-fifths of the Members elected to each House. The Bills providing for the appropriation of funds for the emergency must be passed by a three-fifths vote of the Members elected to each House. If it is determined that the amount of the Budget Stabilization Fund is less than the amount needed to meet an emergency situation, taxes in excess of the limit established in subsection (a) of this Section may be imposed and collected only if all of the following conditions are met: 1. The Governor requests the General Assembly to declare an emergency; 2. The request is specific as to the nature of the emergency, the dollar amount of the emergency and the method by which the emergency will be funded; and 3. Upon receiving the request the General Assembly declares an emergency in accordance with the specifications of the Governor's request by a Joint Resolution adopted by a two-thirds vote of the Members elected to each House. The Bills providing for the appropriation of funds for the emergency must be passed by a two-thirds vote of the Members elected to each House. The emergency must be declared in accordance with these procedures prior to incurring any of the expenses which constitutes the specific emergency request. The revenue limitation may be exceeded only for the fiscal year in which an emergency is

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declared; in subsequent fiscal years the revenue limits of subsection (a) of this Section shall again take effect. An emergency shall not be declared in two successive fiscal years without the approval of a majority of the qualified electors of the state voting thereon and at regularly scheduled election. Income earned from the funds maintained in the Budget Stabilization Fund shall accrue to that fund. (c) For any fiscal year in the event that the amount in the Budget Stabilization Fund exceeds two percent of the revenue limit established by subsection (a) of this Section, the General Assembly shall provide for distribution of the excess revenues in any of the following three methods: 1. Distribution to the various state pension funds established by law in proportion to the respective actuarial reserve deficiencies of the several funds based on the benefits in effect at the time of the effective date of this subsection... of this Section. A person eligible for the Office of Judge may cause his name to appear on the ballot as a candidate for Judge at the primary and at the general or judicial elections by submitting petitions. The General Assembly shall prescribe by law the requirements for petitions. (B) The Office of the Judge shall be vacant upon his death, resignation, retirement, removal or upon the conclusion of his term without retention in office. Whenever an additional Appellate or Circuit Judge is authorized by law, the office shall be filled in the manner provided for filling a vacancy in that office. (C) A vacancy occurring in the

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Office of Supreme, Appellate or Circuit Judge shall be filled as the General Assembly may provide by law. And in absence of a law, vacancies may be filled by appointment by the Supreme Court. A person appointed to fill a vacancy 60 or more days prior to the next primary election to nominate Judges shall serve until a vacancy is filled for a term in the next general or judicial election. A person appointed to fill a vacancy less than 60 days prior to the next primary election to nominate Judges shall serve until the vacancy is filled at the second general or judicial election following such appointment. (D) Not less than six months before the election proceeding the expiration of his term of office for Supreme or Appellate Judge who has been elected to that office may file the Office of the Secretary of State a declaration of candidacy to succeed himself. The Secretary of State, not less than 63 days before the election, shall certify the Judge's candidacy to the proper election officials. The names of the Judges seeking retention shall be submitted to the electors separately and without party designation as the sole question of whether each Judge shall be retained in office for another term. The retention election shall be conducted at general elections in the appropriate Judicial Districts for Supreme and Appellate Judges. The affirmative vote of three-fifths of the electors voting in the question shall elect the Judge to the office for a term commencing on the first Monday in December following his election. (E) A law reducing the number of Appellate Judges shall be without prejudice to the right of Judges affected to seek retention in the office. Article IV, Section 8 - Passage of Bills. (A) The enacting clause of the laws of this state shall be, 'Be it enacted by the

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people of the State of Illinois represented in the Illinois General Assembly'. (B) The General Assembly shall enact laws only by Bills. Bills may originate in the either House but may be amended or rejected by the other. (C) No Bill shall become law without the concurrence of a Majority of the Members elected to each House. Final passage of the Bill shall be by recorded vote. In the Senate at the request of two Members and in the House at the requests of five Members, a record vote may be taken on any other occasion. A record vote is a vote by 'yeas' and 'nays' on the Journal. (D) A Bill shall be read by title on three different days in each House. A Bill and each Amendment thereto shall be reproduced and placed on the desk of each Member before final passage. Bills - Except Bills for appropriations and for the codification, revision or rearrangement of laws shall be confined to one subject. Except as otherwise provided in Subsection (E-2) of this Section, appropriation Bills shall be limited to the subject of appropriations. A Bill expressly amending the law shall be set forth completely in the Sections amended. (E) A Bill which would require the expenditure by a unit of local government or school district of funds, in order to implement that Bill, shall not become law unless either, one, the Bill passes with the concurrence of at least three-fifths of the Members elected to each House or, two, the Bill passes with the concurrence of the Majority of the Members elected to each House and the Bill contains a provision for reimbursement to the unit of local government or school district of funds necessary for the implementation.
