Speaker Hannig: "Mr. Clerk, is a quorum present?"

Clerk Rossi: "A quorum is not present."

Speaker Hannig: "The House shall wait for a quorum to be present. We waited a few minutes here. Mr. Clerk, is a quorum present?"

Clerk Rossi: "A quorum is not present."

Speaker Hannig: "Representative Curran, for what reason do you seek recognition?"

Curran: "Well, Mr. Speaker, there's important business for the First Special Session to consider that should not be delayed. And therefore, I move to adjourn the House until Friday, October 8, 1993, at the hour of 12:00 noon."

Speaker Hannig: "Okay. You've heard the Gentleman's Motion. All those in favor of the Motion say 'aye'. Those opposed say 'no'. The 'ayes' have it, and the House shall stand adjourned for the First Special Session until Friday, October 8, 1993, at hour of 12:00 noon."
