Speaker Moseley: "The hour of 12:00 noon having arrived, the House First Special Session will come to order. We will be led in prayer by Clerk Tony Rossi."

Clerk Rossi: "Dear Lord, bless this House and all who work and serve here. Amen."

Speaker Moseley: "We will be led in the Pledge of Allegiance by Representative Curran."

Curran - et al: "I pledge allegiance to the flag of the United States of America, and to the Republic for which it stands, one nation under God, indivisible, with liberty and justice for all."

Speaker Moseley: "Mr. Clerk, is a quorum present?"

Clerk Rossi: "A quorum is not present."

Speaker Moseley: "The House shall wait for a quorum. Representative Curran, for what reason do you seek recognition?"

Curran: "Madam Speaker, there is important business for this First Special Session to consider that should not be delayed, and therefore I move to adjourn the House until Tuesday, October 12, 1993, at the hour of 12:00 noon."

Speaker Moseley: "A quorum is not present. All those in favor of the Motion say 'aye', those opposed say 'no'. The 'ayes' have it, and the House stands adjourned for the First Special Session until Tuesday, October 12, 1993, at the hour of 12:00 noon."
