Speaker Madigan: "Concerning the Fourth Special Session, the House shall come to order. Is there leave to use the Attendance Roll Call of the First Special Session for the purposes of the Fourth Special Session? Leave is granted. Mr. Clerk, do you have any matters for the Fourth Special Session? All right. Ladies and Gentlemen, the plan is for the Fourth Special Session to stand in recess."

Speaker Madigan: "Ladies and Gentlemen, we committed a clerical error. And we used the wrong number at the wrong time. And so, I'm advised by the Clerk... Mr. Clerk, which Special Session has not yet been adjourned?"

Clerk Bolin: "The Fourth Special Session has not been adjourned."

Speaker Madigan: "Okay. So, we're in the Fourth Special Session and Representative Currie moves that the House stand adjourned until 12 noon tomorrow. Those in favor say 'aye'; those opposed say 'no'. The 'ayes' have it. And the House stands adjourned until 12 noon tomorrow. And with that, we are ready to adjourn completely.
