- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Dental Practice Act is amended
- 5 by changing Section 13 as follows:

- 7 Sec. 13. Qualifications of Applicants for Dental
- 8 Hygienists. Every person who desires to obtain a license as
- 9 a dental hygienist shall apply to the Department in writing,

- 11 application shall contain proof of the particular
- 12 qualifications required of the applicant, shall be verified
