- (1) A person who commits the offense of unlawful purchase of a firearm by purchasing or attempting to purchase a firearm with intent to deliver the firearm in violation of subsection (b) or by purchasing or attempting to purchase a firearm in violation of subsection (c):
  - (A) is guilty of a Class 4 felony for purchasing or attempting to purchase one firearm;
  - (B) is guilty of a Class 3 felony for purchasing or attempting to purchase not less than 2 firearms and not more than 5 firearms at the same time or within a one year period;
