- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Pawnbroker Regulation Act is amended by
- 5 changing Section 11 as follows:
- 6 (205 ILCS 510/11) (from Ch. 17, par. 4661)
- 7 Sec. 11. <u>Violations; penalties</u>. Every person who
- 8 knowingly violates the provisions of this Act shall, for the
- 9 first offense, be guilty of a Class C misdemeanor, and for
- 10 each subsequent offense shall be guilty of a Class A
- 11 misdemeanor, provided, that this Act shall not be construed
- 12 as to, in any wise, impair the power of cities or villages in
- 13 this State to license, tax, regulate except as to fee
- 14 amounts, suppress, and prohibit pawnbrokers as now provided
- 15 by law.
