- 3 "Violent crime" means any felony in which force or threat force was used against the victim, or any offense 4 5 involving sexual exploitation, sexual conduct or sexual penetration, domestic battery, violation of an order of 6 protection, stalking, or any misdemeanor which results in 7 death or great bodily harm to the victim or any violation of 8 Section 9-3 of the Criminal Code of 1961, or Section 11-501 9 10 of the Illinois Vehicle Code, or a similar provision of a local ordinance, if the violation resulted in personal injury 11 or death, and includes any action committed by a juvenile 12 that would be a violent crime if committed by an adult. For 13 the purposes of this Act, "personal injury" shall 14 15 include severely bleeding wounds, 16 extremities, injuries that require immediate 17 attention, and injuries that require the injured party to be carried from the scene; 18
- Section 20. Immigrant crime victim reporting program. 19 20 The Department of Human Services shall establish a program 21 for the investigation of crimes committed against victims in this State who are undocumented residents of the United 22 23 States. The Department shall have the duty and authority to investigate all criminal complaints made by victims who are 24 undocumented residents of the United States and shall not 25 release to any other State or federal agency any identifying 26 information about the victim or his or her family unless the 27 28 victim signs a written document allowing this release of information. Even if the victim does not sign this release, 29 30 the Department has the obligation to investigate the victim's 31 complaint.

- Section 25. Petition by Governor. In cases where the legal immigration status is necessary for the investigation or prosecution of any violent crime or felony offense, the Governor of this State shall petition the appropriate federal agency to obtain legal immigration status for the victim or any witness necessary to the investigation or prosecution.
- 7 Section 99. This Act takes effect upon becoming law.
