- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The State Employee Indemnification Act is
- 5 amended by changing Section 1 as follows:
- 6 (5 ILCS 350/1) (from Ch. 127, par. 1301)
- 7 Sec. 1. Definitions. For the purpose of this Act:
- 8 (a) The term "State" means the State of Illinois, the
- 9 General Assembly, the court, or any State office, department,
- 10 division, bureau, board, commission, or committee, the
- 11 governing boards of the public institutions of higher
- 12 education created by the State, the Illinois National Guard,
- 13 the Comprehensive Health Insurance Board, any metropolitan
- 14 <u>enforcement group established under the Intergovernmental</u>
- 15 <u>Cooperation Act</u>, any poison control center designated under
- 16 the Poison Control System Act that receives State funding, or
- 17 any other agency or instrumentality of the State. It does
- 18 not mean any local public entity as that term is defined in
- 19 Section 1-206 of the Local Governmental and Governmental
- 20 Employees Tort Immunity Act or a pension fund.
- 21 (b) The term "employee" means any present or former
- 22 elected or appointed officer, trustee or employee of the
- 23 State, or of a pension fund, any present or former member of
- 24 the Illinois National Guard while on active duty, individuals
- 25 or organizations who contract with the Department of
- 26 Corrections, the Comprehensive Health Insurance Board, or the
- 27 Department of Veterans' Affairs to provide services,
- 28 individuals or organizations who contract with the Department
- of Human Services (as successor to the Department of Mental
- 30 Health and Developmental Disabilities) to provide services
- 31 including but not limited to treatment and other services for

sexually violent persons, individuals or organizations 2 contract with the Department of Military Affairs for youth programs, individuals or organizations who contract 3 4 perform carnival and amusement ride safety inspections for 5 the Department of Labor, individual representatives of 6 designated organizations authorized to represent the Office 7 of State Long-Term Ombudsman for the Department on Aging, individual representatives of or organizations designated by 8 9 the Department on Aging in the performance of their duties as elder abuse provider agencies or regional administrative 10 11 agencies under the Elder Abuse and Neglect Act, individuals or organizations who perform volunteer services for the State 12 where such volunteer relationship is reduced to writing, 13 individuals who serve on any public entity (whether created 14 15 by law or administrative action) described in paragraph 16 of this Section, individuals or not for profit organizations who, either as volunteers, where such volunteer relationship 17 is reduced to writing, or pursuant to contract, furnish 18 19 professional advice or consultation to any agency 20 instrumentality of the State, individuals who serve as foster 2.1 parents for the Department of Children and Family Services 22 when caring for a Department ward, and individuals who serve 23 as arbitrators pursuant to Part 10A of Article II of the Code of Civil Procedure and the rules of the Supreme Court 24 25 implementing Part 10A, each as now or hereafter amended, 26 does not mean an independent contractor except as provided in this Section. The term includes an individual appointed as an 27 inspector by the Director of State Police when performing 28 29 duties within the scope of the activities of a Metropolitan 30 Enforcement Group law enforcement organization or а established under the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act. An 31 32 individual who renders professional advice and consultation 33 to the State through an organization which qualifies as an 34 "employee" under the Act is also an employee. The term

- 3 (c) The term "pension fund" means a retirement system or
- 4 pension fund created under the Illinois Pension Code.
