- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Highway Code is amended by
- 5 adding Section 4-219 as follows:
- 6 (605 ILCS 5/4-219 new)
- 7 Sec. 4-219. Transfer of property from the Illinois State
- 8 Toll Highway Authority. On or before December 31, 2001, the
- 9 <u>Illinois State Toll Highway Authority shall transfer all of</u>
- 10 <u>its records, documents, property, and assets to the</u>
- 11 <u>Department</u>. The Department shall succeed to all rights and
- 12 <u>interests of the Illinois State Toll Highway Authority at the</u>

- Sec. 40. Abolishing the Authority.
- 27 (a) It is the intention and purpose of this amendatory
- 28 Act of the 92nd General Assembly that the Authority shall be
- 29 <u>abolished and the terms of its chairman and directors holding</u>

- 1 office shall expire on January 1, 2002. At that time, the
- 2 <u>management and operation of the existing toll highways shall</u>
