- Section 5. The Illinois Insurance Code is amended by 4

- Sec. 551. Mandatory stay of proceedings. All proceedings 7

- an-inselvent-company shall be <u>automatically</u> stayed for 120 11

- 15 Order of Liquidation to permit proper defense by the Fund, or
- 16 a similar organization in another state, of all such pending
