

1 AN ACT making appropriations.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 1. The following named amounts, or so much
6 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated
7 for the objects and purposes hereinafter named, to meet the
8 ordinary and contingent expenses of the Illinois Health Care
9 Cost Containment Council:

30 Section 1a. The amount of \$380,000, or so much thereof

1 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
2 Fund to the Illinois Health Care Cost Containment Council for
3 the collection of data on out-patient health care costs in
4 Illinois.

5 Section 2. The amount of \$295,000, or so much of that
6 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois
7 Health Care Cost Containment Council Special Studies Fund to
8 the Illinois Health Care Cost Containment Council for Special
9 Studies pursuant to the Illinois Health Finance Reform Act.

10 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect on
11 July 1, 2002.
