2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois House of
3 Representatives are honored to recognize milestone events in
4 the lives of the citizens of the State of Illinois; and

5 WHEREAS, Sister Susan M. Sanders, RSM, Ph.D., is the
6 Director of the Center for Religion and Public Discourse and
7 an Associate Professor of Public Policy at Saint Xavier
8 University in Chicago, where she teaches ethics, policy
9 analysis and implementation, statistics, and nonprofit
10 organizational behavior; and

12 School of Public Policy at the University of Chicago in 1991;

18 academic policy and trade journals and is currently
19 researching the problem of teen dating violence among high
20 school students; her book, "The Invisible Peril: The Problem

23 by Mother McAuley High School on April 12, 2002 with the
24 Distinguished Alumna Award in recognition of her influence in
25 the tradition of Catherine McAuley and the Sisters of Mercy;
