- 1 AN ACT concerning taxation.
- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Property Tax Code is amended by adding
- 5 Division 4 to Article 11 and by adding Sections 11-130,
- 6 11-135, 11-140, 11-145, 11-150, 11-155, 11-160, 11-165, and
- 7 11-170 as follows:
- 8 (35 ILCS 200/Art. 11, Div. 4 heading new)
- 9 <u>DIVISION 4. REGIONAL WATER TREATMENT FACILITIES</u>
- 10 (35 ILCS 200/11-130 new)
- 11 <u>Sec. 11-130. Legislative findings. The General Assembly</u>
- 12 finds that it is the policy of this State to ensure and
- 13 encourage the availability of safe potable water for our
- 14 <u>cities, villages, towns, and rural residents and that it has</u>
- 15 <u>become increasingly difficult and cost prohibitive for</u>
- 16 <u>smaller cities, towns, and villages to construct, maintain,</u>
- or operate, to current standards, water treatment facilities.
- 19 <u>regional treatment facilities capable of supplying several</u>
- 20 <u>cities, villages, towns, public water districts, public water</u>
- 21 <u>commissions</u>, and rural water <u>companies</u> with treated water
- 22 <u>offer a viable economic solution to this concern and it</u>
- 23 should be the policy of the State to encourage the
- 24 <u>construction and operation of regional water treatment</u>
- 25 <u>facilities capable of providing treated, potable water to</u>
- 26 <u>cities, villages, towns, public water districts, public water</u>
- 27 <u>commissions</u>, and rural water companies, thereby relieving the
- 28 <u>burden on those entities and their citizens from constructing</u>
- 29 <u>and maintaining their own individual treatment facilities.</u>

- 2 <u>Sec. 11-135. Definitions. For purposes of this Division</u>
- 3 4:
- 4 <u>"Department" means the Illinois Department of Revenue.</u>
- 5 <u>"Not for profit corporation" means an Illinois</u>
- 6 corporation organized and existing under the General Not For
- 7 Profit Corporation Act of 1986 in good standing with the
- 8 State and having been granted status as an exempt
- 9 <u>organization under Section 501(c) of the Internal Revenue</u>
- 10 Code, or any successor or similar provision of the Internal
- 11 Revenue Code.
- 12 <u>"Public water commission" means a water commission</u>
- organized and existing under Division 135 of Article 11 of
- 14 the Illinois Municipal Code.
- 15 <u>"Public water district" means a water district organized</u>
- 16 <u>and existing under the Public Water District Act.</u>
- 17 <u>"Qualifying water treatment facility" means a water</u>
- 18 treatment facility that is owned by a not for profit
- 19 <u>corporation whose members consist exclusively of one or more</u>
- 20 <u>incorporated city</u>, <u>village</u>, <u>or town of this State</u>, <u>and any</u>
- 21 <u>number of public water districts, any number of public water</u>
- 22 <u>commissions</u>, or any number of rural water companies and that
- 23 <u>sells potable water to the corporation's members on a mutual</u>
- or cooperative and not for profit basis.
- 25 "Rural water company" means a not for profit corporation
- 26 whose primary purpose is to own, maintain, and operate a
- 27 <u>potable water distribution system distributing water to</u>
- 28 <u>residences</u>, farms, or businesses exclusively in the State of
- 29 <u>Illinois and not otherwise served by any city, village, town,</u>
- 30 <u>public water district, or public water commission.</u>
- 31 <u>"Water treatment facility" means a plant or facility</u>
- 32 whose primary function is to treat raw water and to produce
- 33 potable water for distribution, together with all other real
- 34 and personal property reasonably necessary to collect, treat,

- 3 <u>Sec. 11-140. Valuation policy. Qualifying water</u>
- 4 treatment facilities shall be valued for purposes of
- 5 computing the assessed valuation on the basis of 33 1/3% of
- 6 <u>the fair cash value.</u>
- 7 (35 ILCS 200/11-145 new)
- 8 Sec. 11-145. Method of valuation for qualifying water
- 9 <u>treatment facilities</u>. To determine 33 1/3% of the fair cash
- 10 <u>value of any qualifying water treatment facility in assessing</u>
- 11 the facility, the Department shall take into consideration
- the probable net value that could be realized by the owner if
- the facility were removed and sold at a fair, voluntary sale,
- 14 giving due account to the expense of removal, site

- 19 <u>facilities</u>. In no event shall the valuation set forth in

- 23 <u>Sec. 11-155. Certification and assessment authority.</u>
- 24 For tax purposes, a qualifying water treatment facility shall
- 25 <u>be certified as such by the Director of Natural Resources and</u>
- 26 <u>shall be assessed by the Department of Revenue.</u>
- 27 (35 ILCS 200/11-160 new)
- 28 <u>Sec. 11-160. Approval procedure. Application for</u>
- 29 <u>approval as a qualifying water treatment facility shall be</u>

- 1 <u>filed</u> with the Department of Natural Resources in the manner
- 2 and form prescribed by the Director of National Resources.
- 3 The application shall contain appropriate and available
- 4 <u>descriptive information concerning anything claimed to be</u>
- 5 <u>entitled to tax treatment as defined in this Division 4.</u> If
- 6 it is found that the facility meets the definition, the
