- 12 <u>applicable law or local ordinance if (i) that injury is</u>
- caused by a condition that is not reasonably safe for use by
- 14 motor vehicles in the exercise of ordinary care and (ii) the
- 15 <u>local public entity has actual or constructive notice of the</u>
- 16 <u>existence of that condition in reasonably adequate time prior</u>
- 17 to an injury to have taken measures to remedy or protect
- 18 <u>against that condition</u>. Neither a local public entity nor a
- 19 public employee, however, is liable for an injury to a
- 20 <u>bicyclist who is using any portion or segment of a street or</u>
- 21 <u>highway that is designated as a bicycle lane or bicycle route</u>
- 22 <u>unless the local public entity or public employee is guilty</u>
