- 4 Section 5. The Property Tax Code is amended by adding
- 5 Section 15-107 as follows:
- 6 (35 ILCS 200/15-107 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 15-107. Vacant farmland withheld from development.</u>
- 8 <u>Unimproved property that is not being used for any productive</u>
- 9 purpose and the most recent productive use of which was as
- 10 <u>farmland</u> is exempt from property tax if the following
- 11 <u>conditions are met:</u>
- 12 (1) The owner of the property enters into a written
- 13 agreement with the chief county assessment officer that
- the property will not be developed or its use otherwise
