- 19 United Methodist Church; she earned the distinction of being
- 20 one of three lay women in the United States to be appointed
- 21 by the YMCA to its national Hi=Y Committee for boys and
- 22 girls; she was also the recipient of a humanitarian award by
- 23 the Grove School for services to developmentally disabled
- 24 children; and
- WHEREAS, During World War II, Margaret Kaiser served on
- 26 the local operating committee of the USO; and
- 27 WHEREAS, The passing of Margaret B. Kaiser will be deeply
- 28 felt by all who knew and loved her, especially her daughter,
- 29 Nancy K. (husband, Jackson) Horton; her son, Paul W. (wife,
- 30 Betty) Kaiser; her six grandchildren; and her thirteen great
