WHEREAS, Dr. Haverstock was born on December 6, 1942, the son of Gordon and Geraldine Haverstock; he was raised in Chicago; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Haverstock graduated from the Loyola University School of Dentistry in 1968; he was awarded the Bronze Star for his tour of duty with the U.S. Army in Vietnam; in 1971, he relocated to Geneva, where he began his family dental practice and became an enthusiastic supporter of the community; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Haverstock was a founding member of the dental staff of Delnor-Community Hospital in Geneva, a member of the Fox River Valley Dental Society, the Illinois State Dental Society and the American Dental Association; and
