

AN ACT making appropriations.

**Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented
in the General Assembly:**

ARTICLE 1

Section 5. The sum of \$38,650,800, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of Chicago State University to meet its operational expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012.

Section 10. The sum of \$104,400, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of Chicago State University for awards and grants to students for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012.

Section 15. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of Chicago State University for all costs associated with the Financial Assistance Outreach Center.

Section 20. The sum of \$307,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Professions Dedicated Fund to the Board of Trustees of Chicago State University for all costs associated with the development, support or administration of pharmacy practice education or training programs.

Section 999. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1, 2011.
