

The Illinois Department of Juvenile Justice offers flexible starting and ending times on an individual basis consistent with the needs of the employee, operational need of the agency and applicable supplemental agreements with organized labor.

The Department of Juvenile Justice makes every effort to see that the personal obligations and needs of our employees are met; however, the Department is only able to offer flexible work schedules to employees outside the security areas. A majority of the workforce is comprised of security staff, which operates on three shifts decreasing the ability to be more flexible with security personnel.
