To Whom it May Concern,

The Effingham Police Department received an award for reimbursement of eighteen (18) in-car cameras in 2020. We currently have all cameras installed and used by our 18 patrol officers. The total makeup of sworn staff within the Effingham Police Department is 27. Each camera is powered on by the ignition or startup of the vehicle and each officer has his/her own login. The video capture mode of the camera is then initiated by the emergency lights, the officer, or the mic pack.

All sworn staff and some civilian personnel have access to the storage server for the video files. No files may be altered; however supervisors have access to review officer video footage at their discretion. Periodic reviews are conducted to insure professional public interaction and compliance with EPD Policy and Procedure. This review process is also used for our professional employee evaluations. Civilian staff have access to forward evidence to the States Attorney's Office and to complete necessary FOIA requests.


Attached to this letter is the list of all 18 cameras with their serial numbers.
