## **2018 - Illinois Lottery Flexible Work Plan**

### Section 1

The mission of the Illinois Lottery in regards to Public Act 87-552, is to be flexible in the assignment of work schedules for Department employees to an extent that does not impede the Department from performing its statutory responsibilities in a professional and expedient manner.

### Section 2

Peter Romano, Labor Relations and Human Resources Manager for the IL Lottery is responsible for implementing the Department's plan.

### Section 3

The Department's core operating hours of work are 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. and 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. Of the Department's 149 employees, 113 employees utilize flexible work hours, alternative work schedules, as well as 4-day and 9-day compressed workweek schedules.

### Section 4

The IL Lottery has exceeded the 20% goal established by the Act and will continue to utilize current programs to accommodate employee needs.

### Section 5

The Willard Ice Building houses an on-site day care center in Springfield. Bright Horizons Center provides infant, toddler care, as well as preschool/kindergarten prep for children of State of Illinois employees.
